

I've read all five of the books in the Program series. (More to come.) I was looking forward to Lance's book since he has the most complicated backstory of all the vampires. Charlene Hartnady told that story in the Chosen series. Lance was his typical bad boy self in the "first heat" of the Program. In the second heat, he ignored the females. So I was a little disappointed that this book was pretty fluffy. I was hoping that Lance would go down harder. I wanted to see him grovel a bit. And I was hoping for a tougher woman than Amber. Don't get me wrong. These books are a fun read and the characters are charming. There's some good hot sex and along with the romance. Ultimately, the vampires are sweet alphas who fall hard for human females. But, one thing that is starting to grate on me is the portrayal of human females acting all flustered about sex. Moreover, it's only the good girls who act this way and of course they end up with mates. They are contrasted with the slutty women who lust after vampires like Lance. Vampires are supposed to be highly sexual beings who don't understand why human females don't want to "rut" immediately to test "compatibility." That conflict can lead to some interesting plots. However, I've gotten a fed up with the "prim and proper" women who seem to be protecting their virtue even though they know this is a "breeding" program. There's a lot of no not meaning no and that gets tiresome. Moreover, why is there this double standard when the vampire males can be man whores, but when the women act that way, they are dismissed? In this book, Amber tries to protect her heart and claims that it's "just sex" with Lance. She says, "no" most of the time when she really wants to be with Lance.
