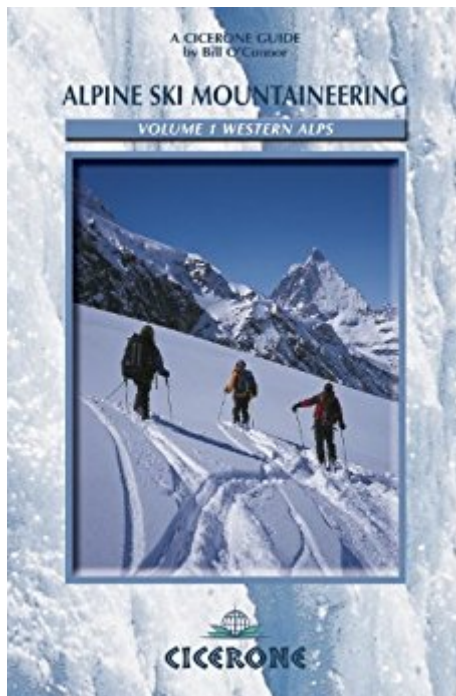

Obviously not all can be encompassed within a volume the size of this book, but with the addition of topo maps(and obviously all your hard gear, experience prep, and exercise), i can imagine very little else needed to travel extensively within the areas discribed. It covers routes from as far West as Le Meije, Chamonix, to Verbier, Monte Rosa and Saas Fee eastward. The other volume covers everything East and North of here. For those planning a trip to the area, this book can answer more

questions than most guides, hut caretakers, or shops will care to about the basics of any of the given areas. Certainly full of better information than days of messing about on the web will find you.
